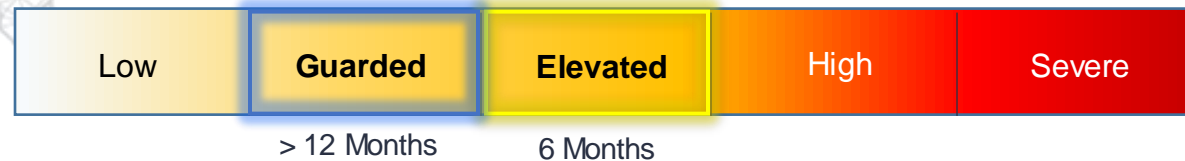

# RELENTLESS

- One of the most active periods for cyber operations
- New and rapid adoption of technologies has been a playground for threat actors
  - Access technologies have been a primary target
- **The supply chain has had a disproportionately negative effect on us all**
  - Continuous threat actor & malware development
  - Continuous experimentation of techniques and tactics
    - Concerning DDoS activity

## THE FALL OUT

- Carefully observing DDoS activity
- More FS breaches are being disclosed (but not all)
- More Supply Chain breaches are being disclosed (but not all)
- **Likely to continue at current level in the short term**

# FUTURE (6-12 Months)

## MORE OF THE SAME

(but possibly a little worse)

- Potential DDoS activity to disrupt payments
- More FS breaches will be disclosed (but not all)
- More Supply Chain breaches will be disclosed (but not all)
- The Supply Chain will also likely be a primary target for Cyber Crime and Nation States
- 'Ransomware and Leak' attacks are highly likely to continue and possibly increase for FS globally
- Nation State level espionage has been high and is likely to continue at these levels
- **Remote possibility threat levels will reduce, more likely to continue at current levels in the short term. It is possible threat levels will increase to HIGH**
- Longer Term: FINTECH and Crypto FINTECH targeting will likely increase
- Longer Term: Regional pivoting
